### Course Description

This hands-on computer course will introduce students to the field of electronic imaging. They will learn to use scanners, digital cameras, and image manipulation software (primarily Adobe Photoshop/ImageReady) properly. There will also be a brief look at iPhoto.

Learning goals will include the following:

- The proper way to scan and the vocabulary of the scanning process
- The use of digital cameras/ Correcting and color correcting digital images
- The vocabulary and concepts of preparing images for printing
- The vocabulary and concepts of preparing images for the web
- Creative techniques for creating digital artwork in Photoshop/ImageReady
