Course Description

This hands-on computer course looks at the advantages and efficiencies of publishing on the World Wide Web (WWW). Starting with the history of the WWW, students will learn how the WWW has revolutionized the information explosion. Included topics will be considerations for developing a Web site, web page design and navigation tips, use of multimedia, as well as Cascading Style Sheets. In addition, students will learn the basic tags of Hypertext Markup Language (HTML) and will code numerous documents as well as create a Web site using Dreamweaver. Finally, students will learn basic Web graphics techniques, and will use Fireworks to generate banners and buttons. Each student will sign up for a free hosting account on Geocities. Finally, students will learn about the Web standards movement that is revolutionizing
